Children in Mediation Parents' Consent Form

- > The meeting will be between the child or children and the facilitator
- > The facilitator will be trained and qualified to speak with children directly during a dispute resolution process
- Attendance at the meeting is voluntary
- > The meeting will take place by agreement with both parents and the facilitator
- The content of the meeting is confidential to the child or children and the facilitator subject to safeguarding rules and policy
- > The child or children will decide, with the facilitator, what information they would like to be shared by the facilitator
- You must not tell your child/ren what to say to us, or ask them to keep anything secret from us or the other parent
- You must not ask your child/ren afterwards to tell you what they have said to us and you must not be cross with them if they decide not to tell us anything
- If they ask us to give either or both of you a message that you may not agree with, you must be willing to listen and acknowledge it
- Attendance at the child's consultation meeting and/or the feedback session shall be deemed acceptance of these terms
